Whoever signs this hire agreement and booking form becomes responsible for the bicycle, from hereon referred to as the 'machine' and accessories, such as helmets, lights, spares pack and toolkit. The signatory is also responsible for the behaviour of all riders of the machine. You must also ensure you and your fellow riders are in good health and are not suffering from any medical conditions or disability, which might adversely affect their normal control of the machine. You all accept there are risks and hazards to cycling. Our triplets and tandems are not designed to be ridden over very rough off-road terrain; please stick to roads and well-surfaced cycle paths whenever possible.

Non-authorized riders:

Hirers must not allow strangers, un-named or unauthorised riders to ride or be carried on our machines during the period of hire. Almost certain insurance invalidation and deposit forfeiture will result if the triplet is involved in an accident while it is being ridden by anyone, or carrying anyone other than those authorised under our terms of business and hire agreement. Hirers must gently but firmly resist the 'pester power' of onlookers asking for a ride.

Cancellation and refunds: Your hire agreement with T-4-3 Triplet Hire Co. Ltd., only comes into effect once we have received your booking form and your deposit; talk with us about the best way we can achieve both. We realise even the best laid plans can fall through. Please notify us as soon as you can if you wish to cancel a ride. If you notify us at least three weeks before your due ride date, we will normally refund your deposit and pre-paid hire fees. But we reserve the right to levy a small admin' charge for doing so.

We do not refund your deposit if you cancel your ride less than three weeks before the due date.

We do not refund the deposit or the full ride fee under any circumstances if you cancel a ride once a bicycle is in your possession and/or your ride has begun.

Please note, we often hire a bike out again within hours or days of it being returned. Please ensure the machine you have used is clean and in full working order. We have made it possible for you to hire an unusual bike and it will be given to you in full working order, but we cannot keep it in good running order once you have begun your ride. Please try and treat the bike as if it were your own. For instance, if the tyres become badly worn on a mega-ride; the chains badly stretched; cables broken; gear changers or brakes develop faults, you are obliged to make every effort to (visit a bike shop or buy replacement parts so you can) return the bike in the same condition as you took it. Essentially, **look after your hire bike and it will look after you**. A clear failure to clean or carry out routine or essential maintenance on your hired bike could lead to full or partial forfeiture of your deposit.

Accidents:

If you are involved in an accident, please make sure you have:

- 1) Names and addresses of third parties and witnesses.
- 2) Reported the accident to the police, even if people involved didn't appear to be hurt or the machine didn't appear to be damaged.
- 3) Do not accept any blame for the accident or insists the other party is at fault.
- 4) Try to photograph all damage to people, other vehicles or people involved.

- 6) Accept you must provide all reasonable help to T-4-3 Triplet Hire concerning any subsequent insurance or legal matters.
- 7) Do not attempt to ride a machine which has been involved in an accident without contacting T-4-3 Triplet Hire first.
